Inaugural Murray River Challenge Charity Fun Run / Half Marathon

Sunday 25th March 2012

11.2 km Charity Fun Run

Runners start at 10.00 am Walkers start at 10.15 am

Starting at Kiewa River car park on the Murray Valley Highway, Killara, 10km's west of Wodonga CBD. The course runs along the banks of the Kiewa & Murray Rivers as well as Wodonga Creek. The course mainly consists of a rough dirt track which can be uneven in places and a slashed vegetated surface. The final stage follows the Wodonga Creek bicycle path which will also have slashed edges.

Drink stations and First Aid will be every 2.5 km's along the course.

21.1km Half Marathon

Runners start at 10.00 am

Participants continue on from the end of the fun run course, heading east over House Creek bridge, running along the banks of Wodonga Creek, Carrolls Creek and Murray River on a slashed, vegetated surface. The course then heads back to finish near Belvoir Park via Carrolls Lane and the old Stock Route, which are both dirt surfaces. Participants are requested to stay on the far right of the road not more than two abreast as these roads will still be open to local traffic.

- Pay via cheque, direct debit or credit card as per registration form. Online entry opens: 8 February and closes Thursday 22 March 2012.

Entry on the day:

- Please help us by entering early. Entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the event start time with lodgement at the start area in Killara.

Entry Information:

- Each participant must have their own registration form.
- Participants under 18 will need parental consent.
- No pushbikes, scooters, roller-skates, skate-boards etc. are allowed.

Facilities

- We encourage participants to park at the end of the event in an area adjacent to the Stocky's Bridge on Wodonga Creek. Courtesy buses will transport participants to the start of the fun event leaving from 8am to 9.40am.
- Toilet facilities are available 1km away at nearby Belvoir Park / Sumsion Gardens for use prior to and after the event. Portaloos will be provided at the start of the event at Killara.
- BBQ lunch and refreshments at Wodonga Creek at the end of the Charity Fun Run.
- First Aid Volunteers available.

Parklands Albury Wodonga

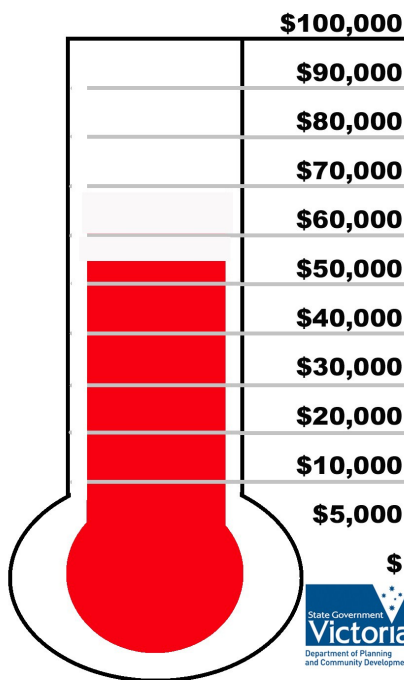
is a cross-border, community managed social enterprise. We work with volunteers from all walks of life to build skills, understanding and stewardship of our regional bush park network.
