5. We are concerned for your safety, but it still remains your responsibility. Have fun by staying safe.

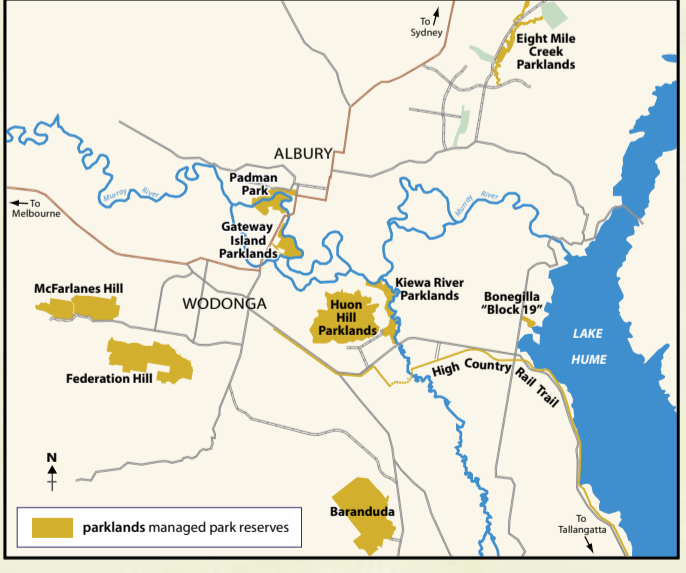

Codes to locations

Huon Hill Parklands

HH-S Turn left off Murray Valley Highway into Whytes Road at Wodonga Sale yards. At T-junction turn right into Kenneth Watson Drive. Meet at car park 4km past entrance.

HH-HF (Hidden Forest) As above. Meet 2 km past entrance.

McFarlanes Hill

MCF Meet at car park on Felltimber Creek Road, 300m past Ingrams Road.

SW Swainsona Reserve - Felltimber Creek Road, 3km past Ingrams Rd.

Federation Hill Parklands

FED Meet at access gate off Ballara Drive. Turn off Yarralumla Drive into Barton Street, then into Ballara Drive.

Padman Park

PADP Meet at corner of Day Street and Padman Drive Albury.

Gateway Island

GI Meet at parklands Office, Gateway Village Lincoln Causeway

Kiewa River Parklands

KRP Meet at parking area, off Murray Valley Highway, 400m past Killara

Beating around the bush...

These walks will get you out experiencing your regional parklands. Join one of our friendly guides to experience the sights and sounds of the natural environment. Sturdy footwear, suitable clothing, hat and bookings are essential. (Family=2 adults/2 children, additional children \$1ea)

1. Hidden Forest walk
