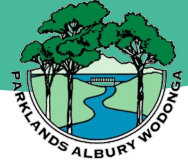


# Project 66

Project 66 links the Wagirra and Gateway Island trails to Lake Hume, extending the Murray River Red Gum Trail to form the upper section of Murray Regional Tourism's Murray River Adventure Trail.

Utilising waterfront crown reserves to showcase the unique riverine landscape, the new Murray River Red Gum Trail will be a major high quality asset supporting tourism in the Albury Wodonga area.

This community-managed nature trail will provide public access to the river for a range of day use recreational activities. The trail will complement current regional trails, providing a different setting and offering new experiences.

Parklands Albury Wodonga will partner with community, business and government to establish and manage this exciting new venture.
